Our primary responsibility is to ensure the welfare and safeguarding of our children and adult learners, and we expect all staff, volunteers, contractors and visitors to share this commitment.

Please be aware that when you sign in at Jigsaw you are agreeing to abide by our guidance to ensure safe visiting.

COVID-19

This section should be read in conjunction with our standard Visitor Guidance (see pages 4-8) and includes notes on additional measures we have in place to ensure the welfare and safety of our staff, learners and any visitors to site during the current Covid-19 situation.

STAYING COVID-19 SECURE

We confirm that we have complied with the government's guidance on managing the risk of COVID-19

5 STEPS TO SAFER WORKING TOGETHER

- ✓ We have carried out a COVID-19 risk assessment and shared the results with the people who work here
- ✓ We have cleaning, handwashing and hygiene procedures in line with guidance
- ✓ We have taken all reasonable steps to help people work from home
- ✓ We have taken all reasonable steps to maintain a 2m distance in the workplace
- ✓ Where people cannot be set 2m apart, we have done everything practical to manage transmission risk

Additional measures visitors should be aware of (but are not limited to) include:

1. Hand washing/sanitising required at all entry and exit points and in each room.
2. Social distancing is enforced wherever possible and all visitors are expected to respect our clearly marked 2m protocol.
3. Meeting rooms will be wiped down prior to new meetings and at the end of each meeting.
4. Meeting rooms will be ventilated where possible regardless of weather.

Additional measures (continued)

5. The wearing of face masks is mandatory for visitors across all Jigsaw sites, including Café on the Park, until further notice.

If you are exempt from wearing a fask mask please inform your Jigsaw host when booking your visit so we may best accommodate your onsite safety.

6. Please ensure you are not showing any of the following symptoms or have been in contact with someone showing these symptoms within the last 14 days: fever; persistent cough; loss or change to sense of smell and/or taste; flu like symptoms. If you have any of these please cancel your visit and do not attend Jigsaw. You will be asked to confirm this upon arrival.
7. **Jigsaw supports NHS Test & Trace***. If you are happy to participate, please complete the Visitor Contact Details Form (found at the back of this document) and hand to Reception upon arrival. Alternatively, you can scan the available QR code at the entrance to each of the ‘bubble’ sectors you visit.

***NHS Test & Trace** - we require name, phone and email only.

This information will be held securely in paper form for 21 days in accordance with NHS Test & Trace requirements. It will only be used if NHS Test & Trace contact us, otherwise it will be shredded immediately after 21 days.

If you scan the QR code, your details will be sent directly to NHS – we have QR codes for each of our ‘bubble sectors’ across our site to ensure we are able to maintain the integrity of each bubble in the event of us being contacted by Test & Trace following an external visit.

Please note: Jigsaw reserves the right to adapt any and all Covid-19 preventative measures it has in place at any time to ensure the ongoing safety and wellbeing of our learners and staff as well as visitors to our site.

KEEPING EVERYONE SAFE

When visiting any of the Jigsaw sites please remember:

- **On arrival** to sign in at Reception and wear your Visitor's badge at all times
- **On departure** to sign out at Reception and return your badge
- **Switch off** your mobile phone. If you need to make an urgent phone call whilst on-site, please speak to the person hosting your visit
- Filming, recording or the taking of photographs is not permitted whilst on-site
- Support the safe use of ICT throughout Jigsaw and respect copyright, data protection and intellectual property rights

DISCLOSURE & BARRING SERVICE (DBS)

JIGSAW CODE OF BEHAVIOUR
